Appendix

Translated excerpt from the Hessian Data Protection Act in the version of 7 January 1999 (GVBl. I p. 98)

Last amended by Article 5 of the Law of 14 July 2016 (GVBl. p. 121).

§7 Permissibility of data processing

(1) The processing of personal data shall only be permissible if

1. a legal provision preceding this Act provides for it or makes it mandatory,
2. this Act permits it, or
3. the data subject has unambiguously consented.

(2) Consent must be given in writing, unless another form is appropriate due to special circumstances. In the case of data processing pursuant to subsection 4, it must expressly refer to the data specified therein. If the consent is given together with other declarations in writing, the data subject shall be specifically informed of this in writing. The data subject shall be informed in an appropriate manner of the meaning of the data, in particular the purpose for which the data is to be used. The duty to inform shall include the recipient of the data in the case of intended transmissions. The person concerned shall be informed, stating the legal consequences, that they may refuse consent and revoke it at any time with effect for the future.
